Our youth are especially at risk in High School and University, often ridiculed, tested and unprepared for attacks on faith. This sometimes results in their loss of faith, underscoring the need to effectively equip them as teens.
- CS Lewis, a renowned 20th century academic and author best known for his "Chronicles of Narnia" series, said it best, "If Christianity is not true, it's of no relevance, but if it is, it's of infinite importance!"
